


The Uniquely Abled Project

- Trains those on the spectrum to be CNC machine operators
- 16-week program, job placement and post-hire support.
- Managed locally.
- Free to trainees.
- Free to employers.
- 95% successful placement rate among the over the 235 graduates to date
- Employers are delighted.


